EC President Ursula von der Leyen talks EOSC in Davos

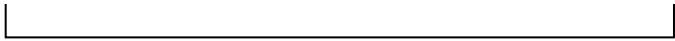

On 22nd January, at the annual meeting of the World Economic Forum in Davos, European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen described “a trusted pool of non-personalised data that governments, businesses and other stakeholders can contribute to...thereby opening up a resource for innovation.”

In a special address which covered work, climate, data, and BREXIT, President von der Leyen stated that Europe would “co-create a framework to allow the use of this data.” She added that the creation of the European Open Science Cloud was underway and that it would be a “trusted space for researchers to store their data and access data from other disciplines.”

The President’s highlighting of the EOSC at the World Economic Forum signals the importance of the EOSC initiative to the EC’s policy priorities. There is no doubt the EOSC will play an important role in Europe’s future.
